Trinidad & Tobogo

This will be a wonderful trip to a very nice warm climate during our winter season, it is not too far away, and they are great people to work with! We will be working with the Trinidad and Tobago Opticians Registration Council (TTORC) and the Lions Club.

The TTORC is a regulatory body that will have to meet and approve the doctor's applications about a day or two ahead of the official clinic days. This will mean that the doctor's will have to travel a few days earlier than the rest of the group.

We will be working for 3 days and will see about 500 patients per day. They will already be prescreened! Meals will be provided onsite through the Lions Club. There will then be time for some R&R for a few days after.

We are currently looking into airline prices through both United and American Airlines, a rough estimate right now is \$750/ticket.

Cusco, Peru July 18th- July 27, 2012

The mission began with a flight to Lima,

Peru where our group spent the night in order to wait for our next flight the following day to Cusco.

We arrived and settled in to either our hotel or hostel. Coca tea was given to us in order to help fight off altitude sickness.

It was quite good and is made from cocaine leaves. We spent an entire day setting up our work location in the municipal building as well as sorting and organizing glasses that the students and optometrists brought with them in to our inventory.

We served 1,800 people in four days! That was about 425 patients a day for twelve hour days.
